WHAT'S HAPPENING IN THE PARK

Scavenger Hunts Around The Park

Explore the park, gather clues, and test your knowledge to earn Smokey Bear prizes with this park trivia activity. "The Quest" is for adults & teenagers and can take a few hours to complete. There is also an easier version available for children. Free to play!



Animal Eye Shine Trail– Explore daily from Dusk to 11PM: Take yourself on a self-guided Night Hike and discover the nocturnal animal stations hidden along the way. Stations are located on the Pool Trail (between campsite 14 and the pool). Bring a flashlight and try to decipher the clues!

Exploring the Flintrock Trail 10:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Take a hike on the Flint Rock Trail with Park Naturalist Reed Cockrell. Identify trees, flowers, and wildlife, while discussing the interpretive signage along the trail. Learn about the unique geology of the mound and why the trail is called "Flint Rock". Meet at Nature Center in the picnic area.

Junior Explorer Program 3:00 PM – 4:00 PM

A drop-in program open to kids and parents. Join the park naturalist in working with your Junior Explorer booklets and scavenger hunt sheets. Work to achieve your Junior Explorers Patch and scavenger hunt prize. Booklets are free at the park office or at the program. Meet at Friends Shelter.
